Ron Westray (b. Columbia, South Carolina) is a dual Canadian—American trombonist, composer, arranger, and educator. He was a long-time member of the **Jazz at Lincoln Center Orchestra** under the direction of **Wynton Marsalis**, serving as lead trombonist and arranger for more than a decade. In this role, he contributed to countless concerts, tours, and recordings worldwide.

Westray has been a collaborator of **pianist Marcus Roberts** since 1991 and has performed with leading artists including **Nicholas Payton**, **Brian Blade**, **Bobby Short**, **Wycliffe Gordon**, and the **Mingus Big Band**. As a leader or co-leader, he has released several acclaimed albums, among them: Bone Structure (1996), Westray Digs In (2002), Medical Cures... (2008), Live from Austin (2011), Jimi Jazz (2014), and Magisteria (2015).

Since 2009, he has held the prestigious **Oscar Peterson Chair in Jazz Performance** at **York University** (Toronto), where he is Associate Professor in the Department of Music, School of the Arts, Media, Performance & Design.
